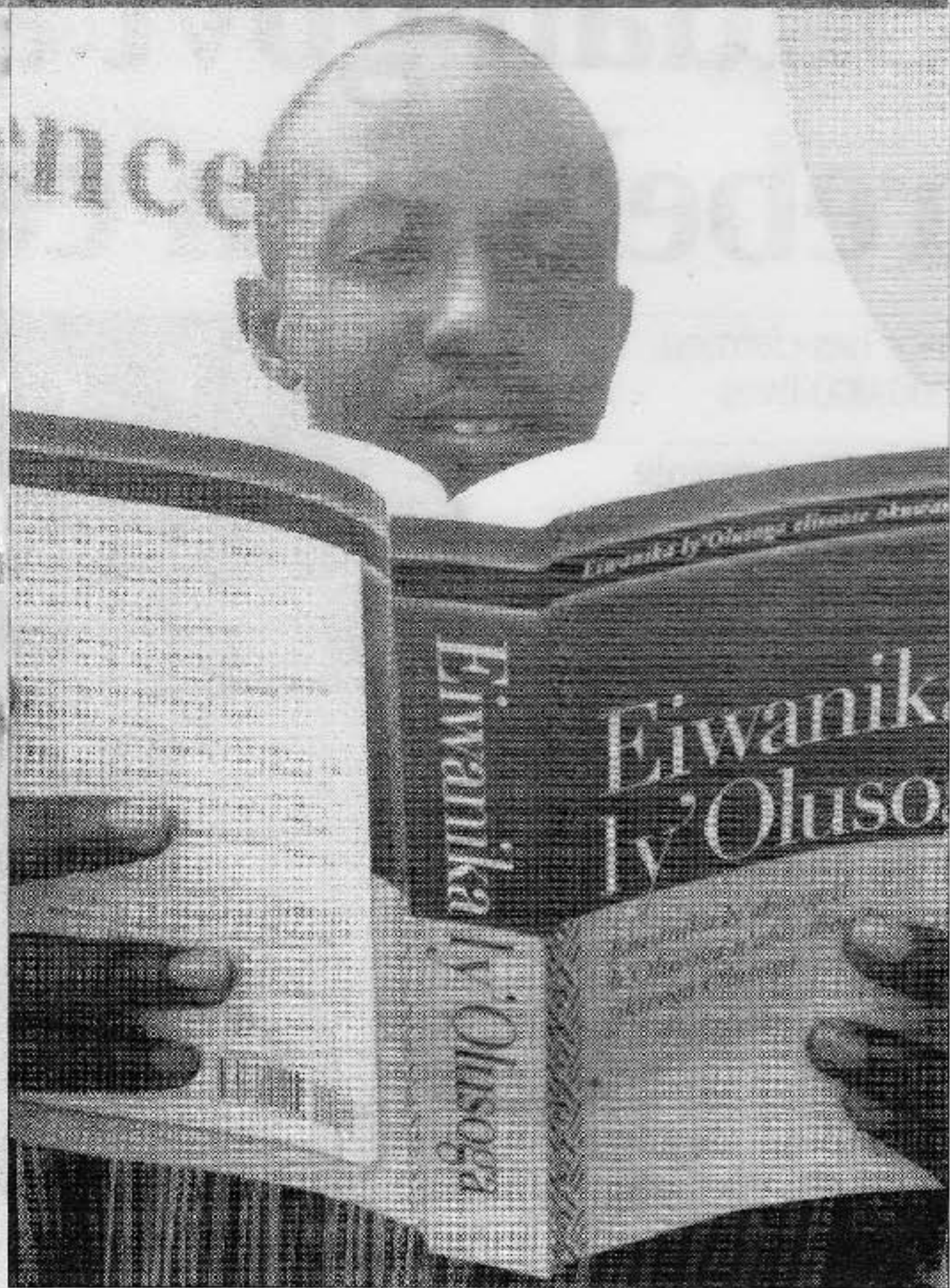


Dictionary in 3 local languages out
